(General Rules & Guidelines)

1. Registration charges – Rs. 500 per team (will be refunded following the presentation).
2. Students are free to form team (students, from different institutes of UTU, are encouraged to form a team)
3. Team should have a maximum of five students.
4. Innovative ideas in the following domains are invited:
 - a. Water harvesting
 - b. Waste management
 - c. Energy conservation
 - d. Solutions to improve the QoL of differently abled people
 - e. Innovative IT-apps
 - f. Process chemistry
5. Participants must submit a two page summary of idea under the following heading; background, literature/ market search, competitive analysis, operations, finance and milestones. In addition, the proposed idea must include the analysis of feasibility component.
6. Selected ideas will be called for presentation before the expert committee. It is advised to keep back-up copy of documents related to idea. This will enable the team to continue the presentation even following power failure.
7. Selected projects will be provided proof-of-concept and mentoring support from the University.
