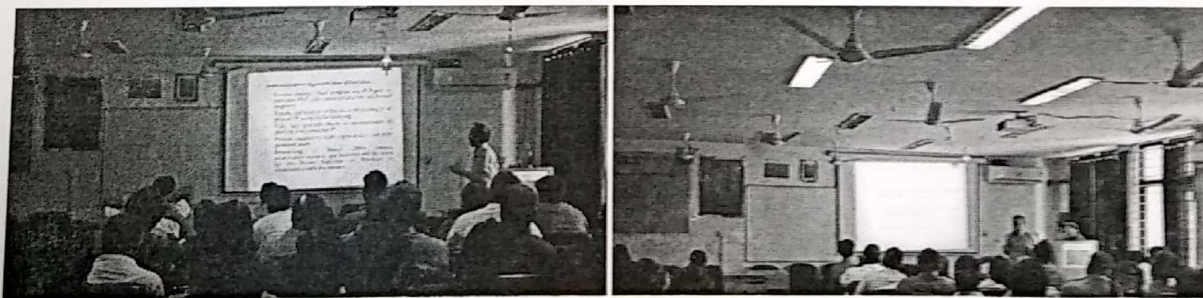
Brief report on IPR guideline program




