4. Scopes/ Objectives
5. Block diagram/ Methodology

6. Working principle
 7. Its advantage and disadvantages
 8. Future Work
- Teams will be given a space to set up their model/design at the venue for exhibition and for judging.
 - All 1st ranked participants at Department level as well as institute level will receive Certificate, Medal and Gift.
 - The decision of the judges shall be treated as final and binding.
 - The panel of judges consists of subject experts from various Departmental Head & Industry representatives.
