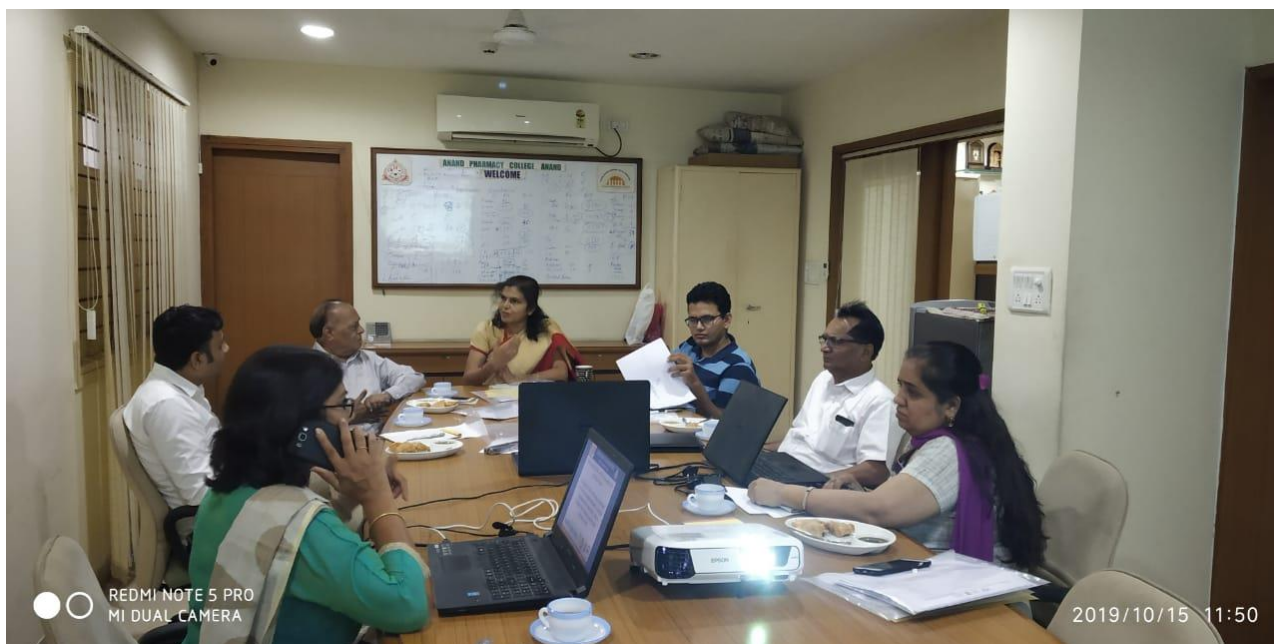
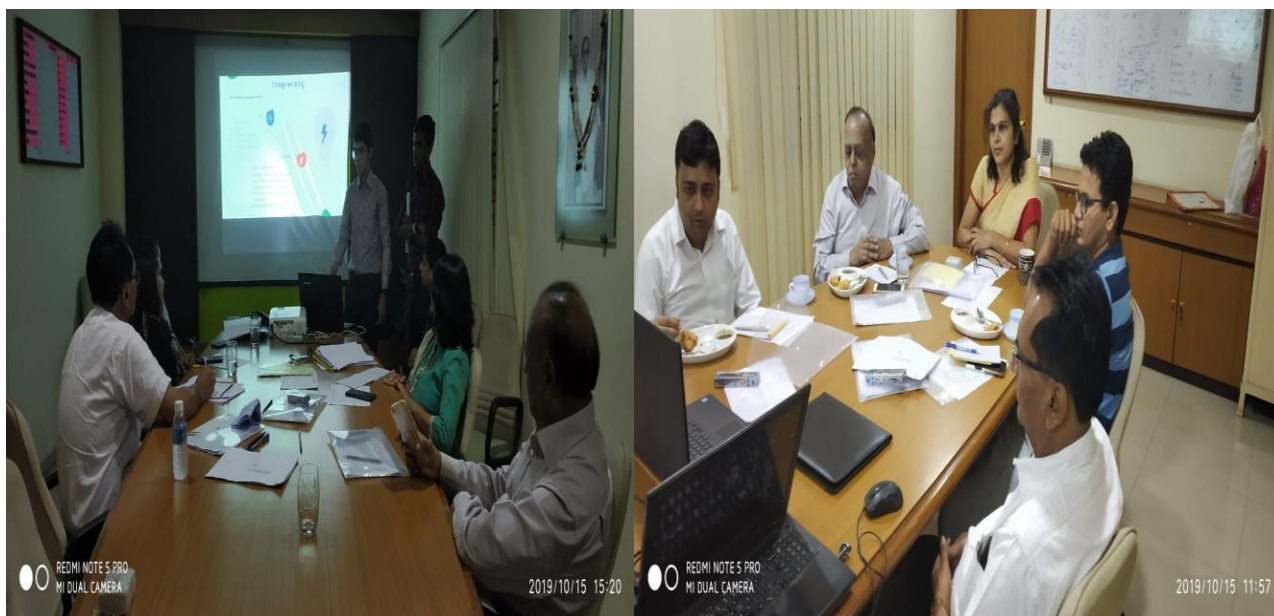

The celebration started with the screening of POC and pitching new ideas by 20 participant form across the colleges of Gujarat from the Pharmacy field.
