UNITEDWORLD INSTITUTE OF DESIGN at Karnavati University along with IIC, KIIF and SSIP organized a documentary appreciation through group discussions on “National Science Day”.

A documentary on Sir C V Raman’s life and his work was screened for the students to support their understanding of science and motivate them to do something innovative in life. It was followed by a group discussion on his learning’s.

A brief about Sir Raman’s past and how he was important in the science world was given by Prof. Arun Gupta.

Sir CV Raman was the first non-white and Indian to receive a Nobel Prize in this domain. He was nominated three times but won only the third time due to his exceptional discovery of the behaviour of light wavelength while travelling in a transparent medium.

After the screening, students were asked to share about what they learned from Sir CV Raman’s life through a group discussion by Prof. Yatra.

They shared some of the life lessons they learnt like:-

- The importance of failure in a successful journey
- Every step we take teaches us something
- Failures may set us back to a few steps but will teach us how not to proceed in the same direction again.
- The experience from failures is valuable

Prof Arun Gupta listening to the groups told that we do not have control over who comes into our lives but we can surely learn from the lessons taught by the circumstances which was exactly what Sir CV Raman did in his life.
