- ✓ Plagiarism of any nature is not allowed. Anyone found infringing upon others' copyright would be disqualified from the contest.

## **Technical Parameters:**

- 1. Photographs must be of high resolution.
- 2. Photographs should be submitted in JPG/PNG/JPEG format and should be of postcard size of 4X6 inches.
- 3. Size of the Photographs should not exceed 20 MB.
- 4. The photo to be submitted by the participant shall be devoid of any copyrighted images.
- 5. There should not be any watermarks on the picture or any other similar markings.
- 6. Any kind of selfies with the product or the process associated to manufacture a GI will not be considered.
- 7. The Photograph can be in color (s), monochromatic, or black/white.
- 8. The Photograph can have been digitally enhanced (such as light, contrast, filters). However, all elements must be 100% photographic with no additional elements, that is the photographs do not include or exclude elements digitally. For example, the photographs should not include or exclude objects, people, images, text, other photos, drawings, collage, etc.
- 9. The photograph to be submitted must have title
- 10. The file should be named as follows: (PARTICIPANT NAME)\_(CATEGORY NAME).
- 11. One profile photo of the Participant, not smaller than 1MB and not larger than 5MB in JPG, JPEG formats (the Profile Photo).
- 12. Brief description by the participant about the photo of Registered GI.

Through this activity, DPR cell, ADC aims to celebrate and make widely known the **Dndigenous** Geographical Indications of Ondia, as well as vaise awareness about it through the captured photographs.

Participation is meant to encourage students to know and understands indigenous culture of Ondia and protect it.
