# A Report on The regional round of New India Vibrant Hackathon'23 hosted by Anant National University, Ahmedabad Gujarat

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#### 1. Anant National University – An Introduction:

Anant National University is the best design university in Ahmedabad India, aims to equip designers with tools of the digital age and a multidisciplinary approach to bring sustainable solutions to the challenges of the contemporary world. Industries across sectors are seeking designers who possess knowledge of multiple domains and can use their interdisciplinary expertise to create solutions for a better future. At AnantU, we aim to mould such designers who possess technical skills, and a holistic understanding of context and are also good communicators, collaborative workers and critical thinkers.

# 2. The AARAMBH – Incubation Center, Anant National University - An Introduction

AARAMBH - the Incubation Centre at Anant National University promotes the entrepreneurship culture in and around the campus by offering various platforms to budding entrepreneurs where they can experiment with their business ideas, get mentorship from recognized entrepreneurs, interact with investors, government as well non-government agencies and create own organization/enterprise.

Launched in 2021, it is aimed at creating startups focusing on the core-built environment with a subset of design, architecture, technology and sustainability. Aarambh aims at facilitating the conversion of research activity into entrepreneurial ventures and thus is actively collaborating with Government, Industry and Academia.

In addition to Anant National University, Aarambh is also supported by the Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP), the Government of Gujarat and IIT Kanpur.

#### 3. Regional Round of New India Vibrant Hackathon 2023: An Introduction

Anant National University, Ahmedabad, India's first DesignX University, has been chosen as one of the Nodal centres for the Regional Round of the New India Vibrant Hackathon 2023, scheduled on the 4th of November. In this one-of-a-kind open innovation challenge, various government departments and industries have posed over 250 problem statements that need solutions. Anant National University will host about 600 college and school students across India to solve important problem statements ranging from climate change to automation, smart policing and health care. 30 students from Anant National University have been shortlisted for the Regional Round.

The Hackathon has been organized by the State Education Department and the Student Startup & Innovation Policy of the Government of Gujarat. The Hackathon is being held as a pre-event of the Vibrant Gujarat Summit.

#### 4. About the Event,

Anant National University (AnantU), Ahmedabad, India's first DesignX University, has been chosen as one of the nodal centres for the regional round of the New India Vibrant Hackathon 2023 along with 13 other universities/institutes across Gujarat, scheduled on the 4th November'23. In this one-of-a-kind open innovation challenge, various government departments and industries have posed over 150 problem areas in sectors like Smart Education, Clean and Green Technology, Energy, Smart Automation, Digitalization, Health and Sports, Social Impact, Logistics and Infrastructure, Clean and Green Technology, Urban Governance & Security that need solutions. These 93 teams, worked non-stop for 11 hours (8 am to 7: 30 pm) and developed creative physical and app-based solutions for these problems. The students were required to choose a problem area from the list and devise inventive ideas to solve it under the guidance of their mentors. 9 teams from the Anant student community also participated in the regional round.

#### 5. Objectives

The student innovator across Gujarat to make systematic efforts to solve one or more problems out of 150 problem statements shared by Government Departments, Offices, and Industries.

#### 6. Benefits in terms of learning/Skills/knowledge obtained

- Exposure to real-world challenges and opportunities to work on them.
- Opportunity to win awards and prizes of approx. ₹ 42 lakhs.
- SSIP 2.0 grant support for PoC/Prototype/Innovation and IP of top team.

#### 7. Details of the Hackathon'22

After the details of the shortlisted team and the jury members were sent by SSIP Gandhinagar to host the regional round of New India Vibrant Hackathon 2023, the required arrangements like availability of classrooms for 93 teams to work for 11hrs (8 am to 7:30 pm) were made along with security, wifi, accessibility to makers space, mattress for resting and breakfast, lunch and high tea. On the 4th of November, 8 a.m. registration on campus was done for the shortlisted participants and were allotted classrooms before 8:30 a.m.

Our host Miss Riya Gupta (Student) started the inauguration by welcoming the dignitaries nodal officers from the Government, jury members, faculty mentors, and the hackathon student participants. Prof. Bhaskar Bhatt, Director, the School of Design and Prof. Milind, Director, Makerspace were invited to address the gathering about the importance of design and innovation and SSIP 2.0 policy respectively. The participants were later briefed about the do's and don'ts during the regional round and were directed to their respective classrooms allotted as per the team.

Following the inauguration, 26 jury members along with the Nodal Officer Prof. Nirvesh Mehta were briefed about the mentoring and marking schemes as per the guidelines shared by the State Education Department and the Student Startup & Innovation Policy of the Government of Gujarat. The respective jury members regularly mentored each team for 11hrs and finally, the grades were submitted by them to the supervisor in the grading sheets shared by the SSIP Gandhinagar.

#### 8. Certificate Distribution:

The present student team and their members along with their mentors were felicitated by the participation certificate. Following that the Jury Members and Nodal Officers were felicitated with the certificate duly signed by the Registrar and IAS officer.

The event ended with the certificate distribution to Hackathon Committee Members/venue in charge and Student Volunteers followed by vote of thanks.

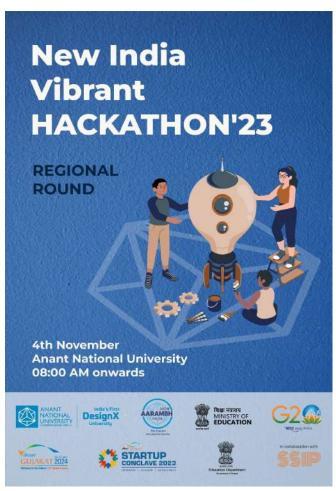
