## REPORT OF MOCK INTERVIEW BY TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL

The purpose of mock interview was to make an effective resume or curriculum vitae, to make students learn how to answer difficult questions, to improve their communication skills, to develop their interview strategies, to reduce their stress before an actual interview, to boost their confidence to help them prepared for behavioural-based interview questions.

Pre-interview session. The resume building activity done by Mr. Devendra Yadav and Pre-interview session was conducted by the Panellists. In resume building activity, the Mr. Devendra Yadav guided about how to build an impactful resume and suggestions/corrections given by him to the students.
