- Challenges: Limited experience, financial resources, networks, and the need for perseverance and determination.

3. Indian Startup Ecosystem:

- India provides abundant resources, including manpower, technology, and investor funding.
- Government support is robust, with schemes like the Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP), ₹960 crore funding allocated in a single year, and ₹828 crore sanctioned for infrastructure development.
- The booming economy offers endless opportunities for new ventures.

4. Institutional Support at PPSU:

- P P Savani University offers funding of up to ₹2.5 lakh per idea, which is non-recoverable in case of failure.

5. Steps for Starting a Startup:

- The startup journey includes idea generation, market research, validation, proof of concept (PoC), business planning, securing funding, and marketing.
- Participants were introduced to tools, mentorship, incubation opportunities, and networking resources to support their entrepreneurial journey.

6. Government Policies and Support Systems:

- Gujarat's SSIP policy empowers young innovators with funding, intellectual property support, and resources for prototype development.
- Financial provisions include support for patents, copyrights, and trademarks.
- Collaboration with government initiatives and access to workshops, events, and mentorship programs to accelerate startup growth.
