About Event:

1. Objective of the Workshop

The workshop by SSIP CELL–RCTI AHMEDABAD on Mentor's Capacity Building for Students' Startups and Innovation Policy (SSIP) was organized with the primary aim of strengthening the mentoring ecosystem within technical and diploma institutes. The program sought to equip faculty members with the necessary skills, frameworks, and insights to effectively guide and support student-led innovations and startups under the SSIP framework.

2. Participants

The workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from faculty members across various diploma disciplines. A total of 34 mentors attended, representing multiple disciplines such as core engineering, IT sectors and Textiles & Printing Technologies.

3. Key Themes Covered

The sessions were designed to be interactive and insightful, covering the following core themes:

Introduction to SSIP 2.0: Overview of the policy, objectives, and implementation framework.

Understanding Innovation and the Startup Mind-set

Role of a Mentor in the Innovation Journey

Ideation to Prototype: Tools for Guiding Students along with Basics of IPRs

Funding and Support Mechanisms under SSIP

Ethics and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in Innovation

Outcome of Event and Feedback

Faculty members gained clarity on their roles and responsibilities as SSIP mentors.

Participants expressed increased confidence in guiding students through ideation, prototyping, and funding stages. The workshop fostered cross-institute collaboration and sharing of best practices.
