It was organized by SAC ISRO, Ahmedabad with DECU, GUJCOST and Gujarat Science City during 4th to 9th April’ 2022 at Vigyan Bhavan, Science City, Ahmedabad.

The program schedule was as follows:

3 April 2022: On spot quiz on space and astronomy

4 April 2022: Colouring on theme crew module using crayon and drawing sheet
