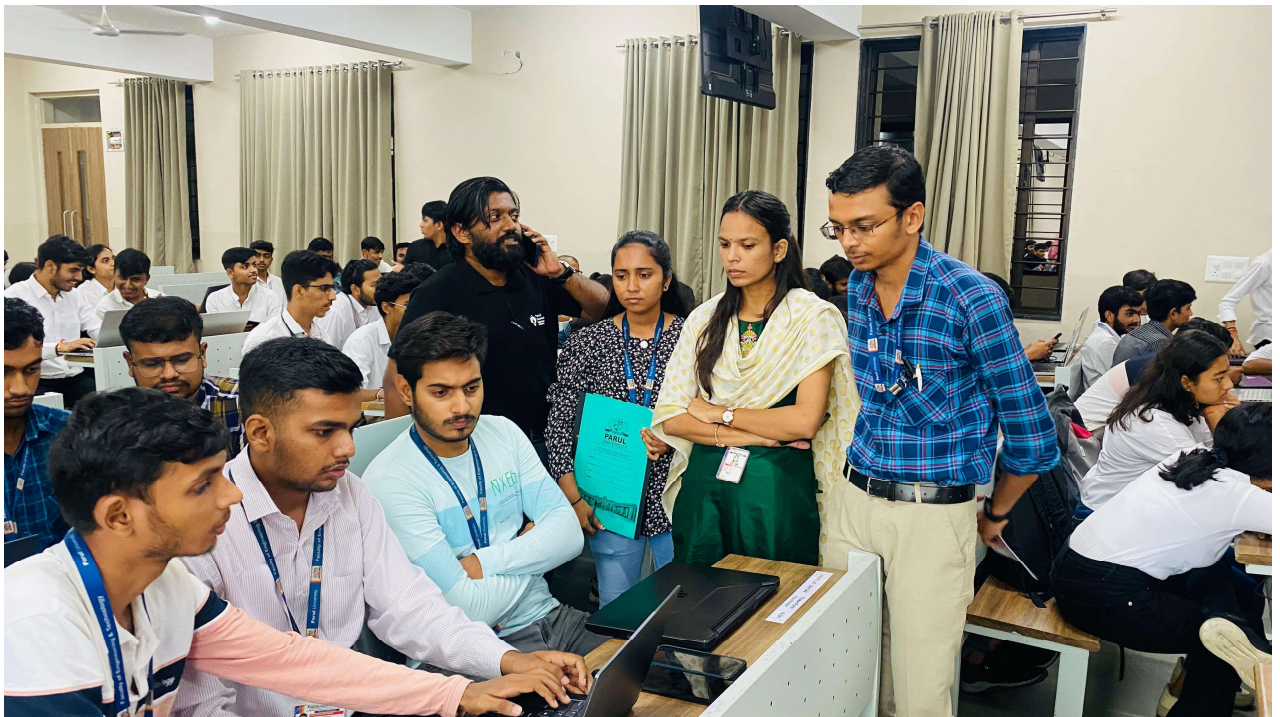

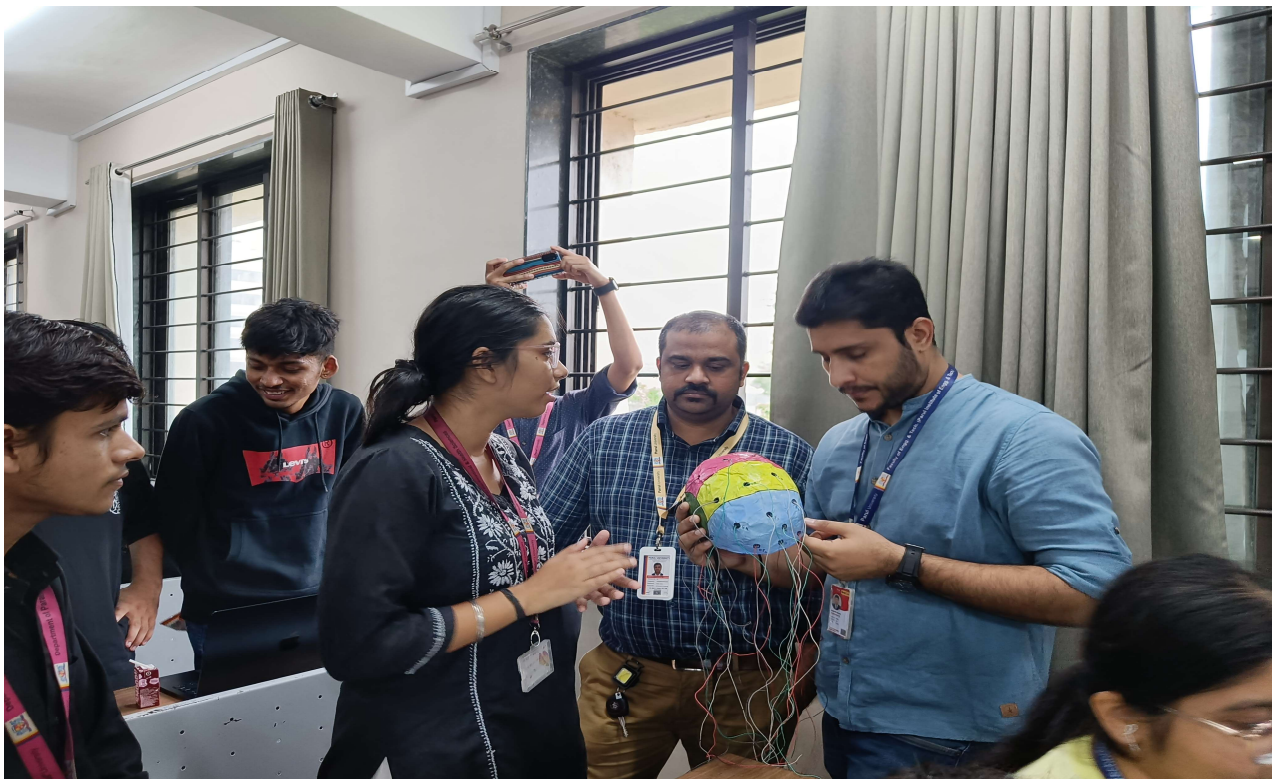

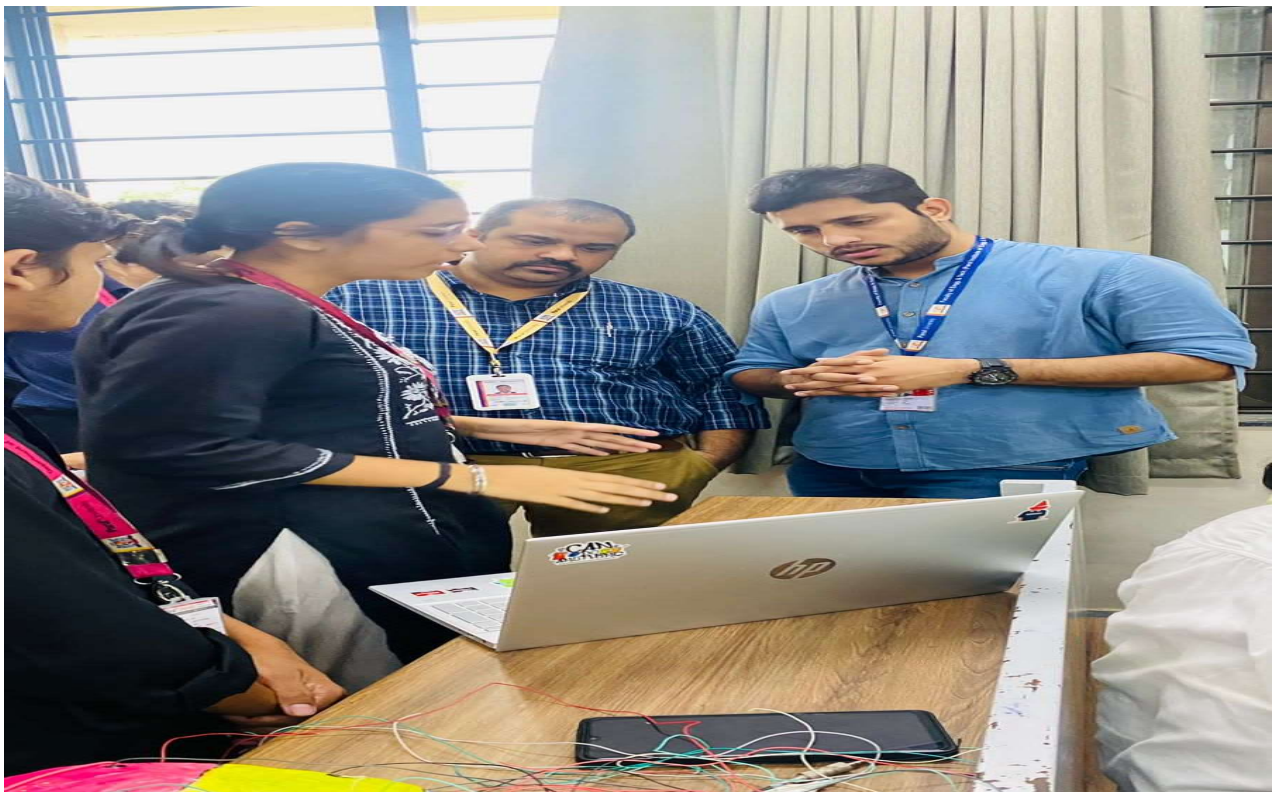

Judging Process:

The judging process for Vadodara Hackathon 4.0 was designed to be fair and transparent. It involved the following steps:

Project Presentations: Each participating team presented their project to a panel of judges. They demonstrated their solutions, explained their approach, and highlighted the impact of their projects on solving the chosen problem statement.

Q&A Session: Following the presentations, judges engaged in a question-and-answer session with each team to gain a deeper understanding of the projects and assess the teams' knowledge and commitment.

Scoring: Judges evaluated each project based on predefined criteria, including innovation, feasibility, impact, and presentation quality.

Deliberation: Judges deliberated to determine the winners and finalists in each problem statement category.

Prize Money:

Twenty thousand rupees in prize money were awarded to a total of four teams, while 35 teams advanced to the final round of the Smart India Hackathon, and an additional 25 teams were chosen for incubation to transform their innovations into startups."
