#### **Activity Details:**

The "Exposure and Field Visit for Problem Identification" event organized by Prof. Barot Kaushal K, Mr. Punit Sompura, Dr. Neelam Mahala, Parul University's Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) in collaboration with the Entrepreneurship Development Centre (EDC) on October 3rd and 4th, 2023. This two-day session was aimed at engaging students in identifying and addressing real-world societal problems while fostering entrepreneurial thinking. The aim of the session was to help students identify and comprehend societal problems and develop potential solutions. To motivate and encourage students to consider entrepreneurship as a means to create positive societal impact. To actively engage students in solving practical, real-world problems. Students were introduced to the goals of the program and briefed on the significance of addressing societal issues.

The event brought together a total of Six teams, each consisting of enthusiastic and skilled students eager to demonstrate their abilities. The day began with a brief orientation by the faculty coordinators, Prof. Barot Kaushal, Mr. Punit Sompura and Dr. Neelam Mahala. They provided an overview of the event's objectives and rules, emphasizing the importance of field visit and its importance. The teams were then led to the designated cafeteria area, security cabin area and other places in campus and out of campus where they were discussed with owner's of respective places and find the problem's they are facing in real time.

Additionally, students were introduced to the concept of entrepreneurial thinking and innovation as tools to address real-world issues effectively.
