Activity Details:

There was a exhibition on "Knotting Yarns" work guided by Asst prof Haana Chauhan and Dr. Shruti Tiwari on 25 Sep 2023 at Parul Institute of Design, Parul University.

The collaborative project between fashion and interior design students aimed to explore the intersection of fashion and interior design through the creation of unique garments. This interdisciplinary endeavor sought to foster creativity, teamwork, and cross-disciplinary understanding among the participating students.

The project began with a brainstorming session where students from both disciplines exchanged ideas, sketches, and inspirations. They then selected a theme that would serve as the foundation for their designs.

Macramé is a versatile and creative craft that involves the art of knotting cords together to create intricate patterns and designs. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced crafter, learning how to use macramé technique can be a rewarding and enjoyable experience. The workshop started with Learning the foundational knots - the square knot, half-square knot, and lark's head knot. Practice these knots until you're comfortable with the techniques. Exploring different patterns and designs. Maintaining consistent tension in your knots for a neat and uniform appearance in your work.

Fashion students took charge of designing the garments, focusing on materials, patterns, and silhouettes, while interior design students worked on complementary accessories and interior elements. Regular design meetings allowed for feedback and adjustments throughout the process. The project culminated in a stunning showcase, where the garments were modeled and displayed alongside interior design elements that complemented the overall theme. The event garnered positive feedback from faculty, peers.

The collaborative project between fashion and interior design students not only pushed the boundaries of creativity but also fostered valuable skills in teamwork and





communication. It demonstrated the potential for cross-disciplinary collaboration in the world of design and left a lasting impact on the participants.
