Event Details:

The Institute of Advanced Research hosted an exciting start-up quiz competition called the "Shark Tank Business Battle" on January 5, 2024. As the name suggests, this event challenged participants' knowledge of key startup terminologies, business concepts, and participants did real-time investment analysis for startups featured on the popular show Shark Tank India. The registration deadline for the event was January 3, 2024.

The quiz competition comprised three engaging rounds, and teams of 1 to 3 members were allowed to participate.

Round 1: "Khata Khol"

In this round, teams were asked general questions on business concepts. Each team had the opportunity to answer questions specifically given to them, testing their fundamental business knowledge.

Round 2: "Dan Dana Dan"

This was a fastest-finger-first round, where teams raced to provide the correct answer first. The team that answered correctly and the quickest scored points in this rapid-fire round.

Round 3: "Be the Shark"

The final round, "Be the Shark," challenged the top teams from the first two rounds to analyze individual pitches from some of Shark Tank India episodes. The team whose analysis most closely matched the actual investment made by the Sharks on the show earned the highest points.

After three exhilarating rounds, the top three winning teams were awarded medals and certificates, celebrating their remarkable business acumen and quick thinking.

The "Shark Tank Business Battle" provided an engaging platform for participants to showcase their entrepreneurial knowledge, analytical skills, and ability to evaluate business opportunities effectively. It was an event that fostered a spirit of healthy competition and a deeper understanding of the dynamic startup ecosystem.

Key Outcomes:

1. **Knowledge Enhancement:** The event provided participants with an opportunity to enhance their knowledge of business concepts, start-up terminologies, and investments. Through the various rounds and questions, participants were able to test and expand their understanding of the entrepreneurial ecosystem.
2. **Analytical Skills Development:** The third round, "*Be the Shark*," challenged participants to analyse and evaluate start up pitches from Shark Tank India episodes. This exercise helped participants develop their analytical skills, critical thinking abilities, and decision-making processes when assessing business opportunities.
3. **Competitive Spirit:** The event fostered a spirit of healthy competition among participants. By allowing teams to compete against each other in different rounds, it encouraged participants to stay motivated, think quickly, and strive for excellence.
4. **Entrepreneurial Mind-set:** The event's theme and structure, cantered around the popular show Shark Tank India, exposed participants to the world of entrepreneurship and start-ups. This exposure likely inspired and encouraged participants to consider entrepreneurial pursuits or explore career opportunities in the start-up ecosystem.

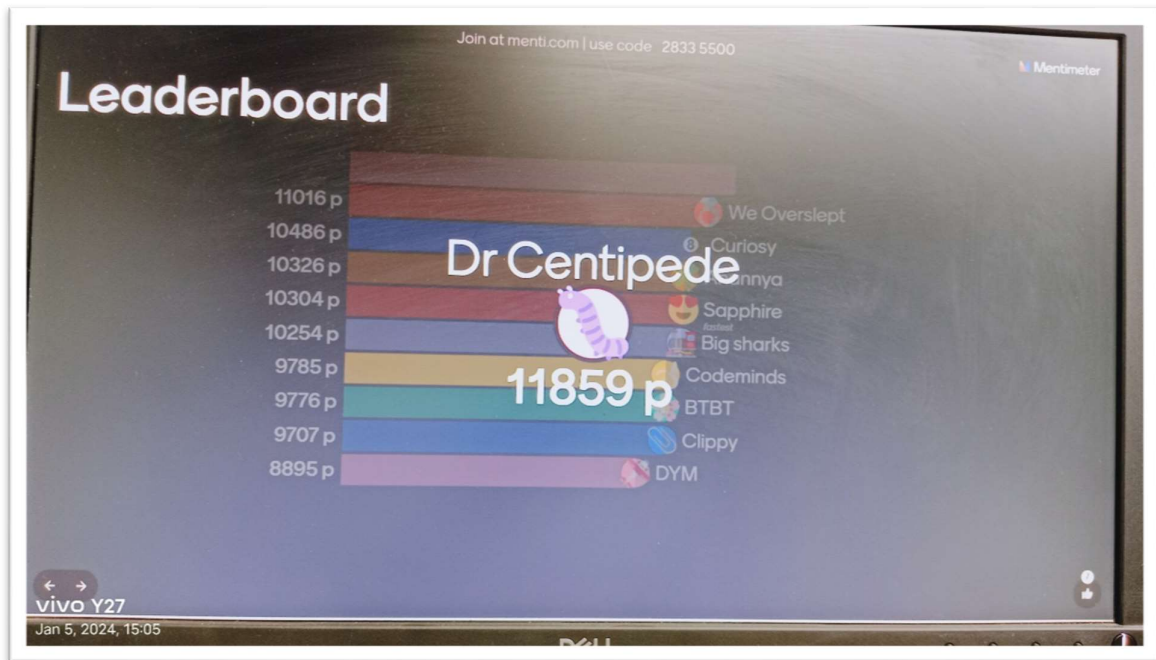

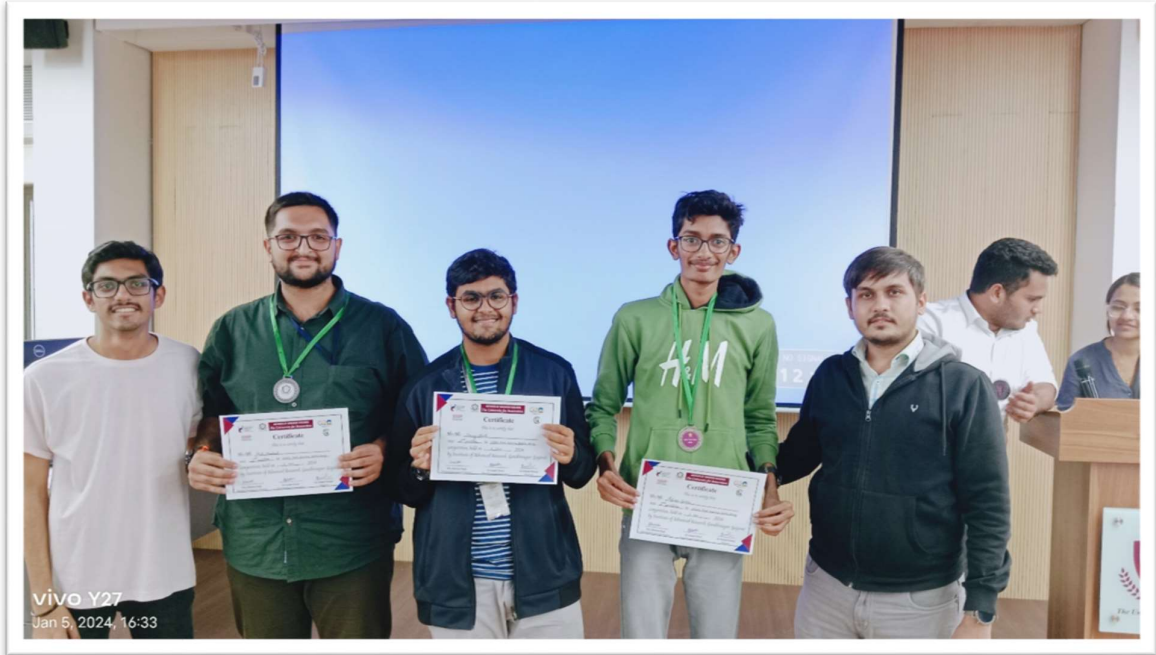
