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1. Anant National University – An Introduction:

Anant National University is the best design university in Ahmedabad India, and aims to equip designers with tools of the digital age and a multidisciplinary approach to bring sustainable solutions to the challenges of the contemporary world. 4. About the Event

Mr Hiramnay Mahanta and Mr Yash Pandya gave the Anant team a tour of the new i-Hub building

- Future collaboration with i-Hub

Dr Anunaya Chaubey suggested a formal MoU between i-Hub and Anant National University at the university campus. Mr Hiranmay Mahanta suggested conducting a one-day Faculty Development Program for 50 faculty and staff members on 20th April. Dr Dhara Thakore to cross check with the academic calendar for the availability of a maximum number of faculty members for participation. Dr Chaubey and Mr Mahanta suggested that the faculty interaction should be conducted once every month. Prof Milind Chitale enquired regarding adding Anant's faculty members in the mentor pool list of i-Hub. Mr Hiranmay agreed and requested to share the faculty list. Mr Hiranmay Mahanta suggested to conduct a session on journey sharing by successful student innovators and entrepreneurs of Anant National University which will motivate their peers to be conducted on the Anant Campus

Sensitization sessions for Anant students, preferably for the second and third-year students to be conducted once every month at the i-Hub campus. Dr Dhara to check the academic calendar and communicate the dates. Mr Mahanta was briefed about the Anant Fellowship in built environment and the entrepreneurship track.. Dr Chaubey suggested to work together with i-Hub for the development of a fellowship in entrepreneurship. Ms Rutvi and Dr Dhara to develop a 3-credit course on New product design. Mr Hiranmay suggested referring to the course outline of IIMs. The industry practitioners from the mentor pool of i-Hub to conduct these courses. Mr Mahanta suggested keeping a tracking mechanism of all ideas/startups supported. The ideas/prototypes which are not taken forward by the innovator could be transferred to the next batch. The IPR of the novel ideas to be purely controlled by Anant National University. Mr Hiranmay Mahanta requested for the list of 8 - 10 students for summer internship at i-Hub. Mr Mrunal from i-Hub to coordinate with Dr Dhara Thakore. Dr Thakore to share the list of the entrepreneurship minor students for the same.

Mr Yash Pandya introduced the Anant team to the i-Hub startups and various schemes.
