#### **Brief overview of the Event:**

The workshop on "Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) and IP Management for Start-Ups" was organized as a critical component of the university's entrepreneurship education program. Recognizing the pivotal role of IP in today's innovation-driven economy, this event aimed to equip students with essential knowledge for protecting and leveraging their intellectual assets. The workshop was held in the university's tech auditorium, providing a conducive environment for learning.

Dr. Vishal Vyas, a distinguished IPR expert with over 3 years of experience in patent law and IP strategy, led the session. Dr. Vyas, formerly with the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and now a partner at a leading IP law firm, brought a wealth of global insights. His expertise spans various industries, making him particularly well-suited to address the diverse interests of our student body.

The workshop covered a comprehensive range of topics: types of IP (patents, trademarks, copyrights, trade secrets), the patenting process, IP valuation, licensing strategies, and enforcement. Dr. Vyas used case studies from successful startups to illustrate how strategic IP management can drive growth and attract investment. A unique feature was the IP audit simulation, where students practiced identifying and protecting IP in hypothetical startup scenarios.

#### **Outcome of the Event:**

The event saw an impressive turnout of 91 students, predominantly from Computer Science, Engineering, and Business programs. This strong attendance reflects growing awareness of IP's importance in the digital age. Students gained a solid understanding of different IP types and their applications—for instance, recognizing when to use patents for novel algorithms versus copyrights for software code.

A key achievement was demystifying the patent process. Many students initially found it daunting, but Dr. Vyas broke it down into manageable steps, from invention disclosure to maintenance. This clarity encouraged several Computer Science students to consider patenting their final-year project

innovations. Engineering students learned how meticulous record-keeping in lab notebooks can strengthen patent claims.

The section on IP management strategies was particularly impactful. Business students grasped how a strong IP portfolio can increase a startup's valuation and negotiate power. They learned to view IP not just as protection, but as a strategic asset for licensing revenue or blocking competitors. Computer Science students saw the value in provisional patent applications, allowing them to secure early filing dates while refining their software.

#### **Feedback from Students:**

Students found the workshop extremely valuable and eye-opening. Many admitted they previously saw IP mainly as a legal formality, but now understand its strategic business importance. They appreciated Dr. Vyas's ability to explain complex concepts in relatable terms, using examples from tech giants like Apple and Google to illustrate IP's competitive edge. Computer Science students were particularly engaged by discussions on software patents and open-source licensing. They gained clarity on what constitutes patentable software and how to balance open collaboration with IP protection. Several expressed plans to review their project codebases for patentable elements.


