Speakers and Key Insights

1. Priyanka Patel, Director, Spaceride Aerotech Private Limited

- o **Personal Experiences with Gender Bias:** Ms. Patel shared her journey as a woman leader in the aerospace industry, highlighting instances where gender bias was evident. She described how she faced skepticism regarding her capabilities and how she tackled these challenges by demonstrating competence and resilience. By focusing on her performance and expertise, she was able to assert her leadership and gain respect from her peers.
- o Creating an Inclusive Workplace: At Spaceride Aerotech, Ms. Patel emphasized the importance of fostering an inclusive environment. She





implemented policies that support women and underrepresented groups, such as flexible working hours, mentorship programs, and equal opportunities for career advancement. These initiatives have positively impacted the company culture, leading to improved employee satisfaction and performance.

Advice for Aspiring Women Entrepreneurs: Ms. Patel advised aspiring women to build a strong network, seek mentorship, and continuously enhance their skills. She encouraged them to stay focused and confident, despite facing gender bias, and to use their expertise as a way to break through barriers in traditionally male-dominated industries.

2. Dr. Trishala Punjabi, CEO, BharatMD

- Navigating Gender Bias in Healthcare: Dr. Punjabi shared her experiences in the healthcare sector, where gender bias is prevalent in leadership roles. She recounted specific instances of being underestimated or doubted and how she overcame these challenges through perseverance and by showcasing her leadership capabilities. Her approach included addressing biases head-on and proving her competence through results.
- Strategies for Empowerment: At BharatMD, Dr. Punjabi implemented strategies such as mentorship programs, leadership training for women, and policies promoting work-life balance. These strategies have helped in mitigating the effects of gender bias and empowering women within the organization.
- Mentorship and Role Models: Dr. Punjabi stressed the significance of mentorship and having role models in her journey. She highlighted how mentors provided guidance, support, and inspiration. She advised other women entrepreneurs to seek out mentors who can offer valuable insights and encouragement to navigate gender bias in their careers.

3. Latika Singh, Co-Founder, CrmOne

Experiences with Gender Bias: Ms. Singh discussed the gender biases she encountered while building CrmOne in the tech industry. She shared strategies such as asserting her expertise, leveraging data to support decisions, and building a strong team to counteract biases. Her proactive approach helped her overcome challenges and establish credibility.





- Building a Diverse Team: Ms. Singh emphasized the importance of diversity and inclusivity within her team at CrmOne. She implemented recruitment practices that promote diversity and created an inclusive work environment that fosters creativity and innovation. The benefits included a richer company culture and enhanced problem-solving capabilities.
- Advice for Emerging Women Leaders: Ms. Singh encouraged emerging women leaders to be persistent and self-assured. She advised them to build a robust professional network, continuously seek knowledge, and challenge gender biases by showcasing their skills and achievements in maledominated industries like tech.
