Objectives:

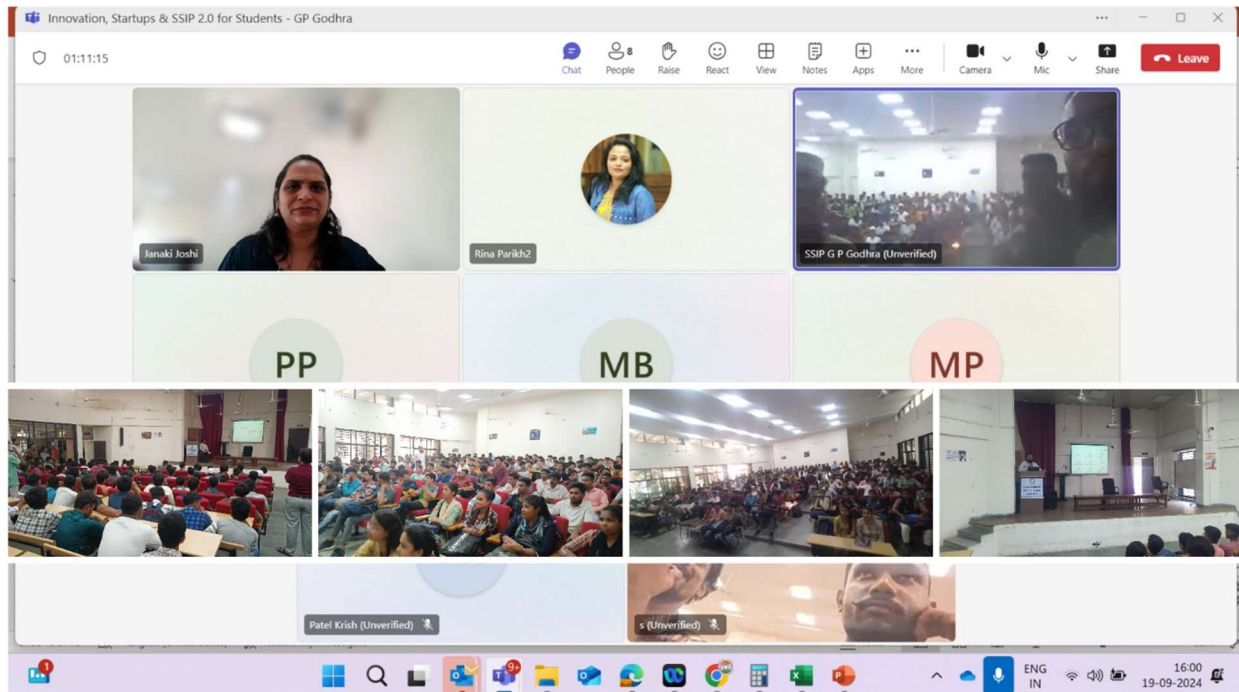
- To introduce students to the key aspects of SSIP 2.0.
