Outcome:

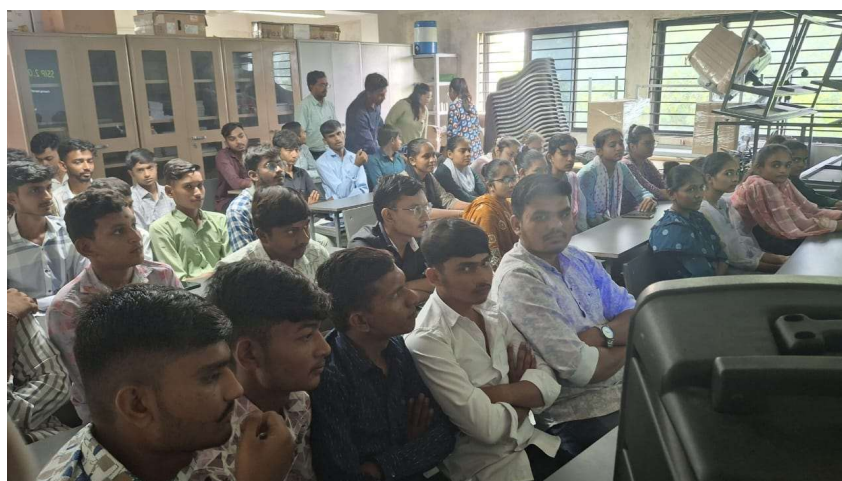
- Students gained a comprehensive understanding of SSIP and its benefits.
