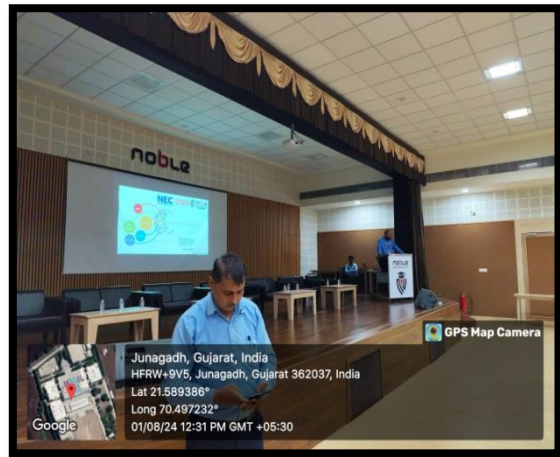
## Key Points
