4) Description of the Event:

As part of the 60-year celebration of Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, a "Startup Awareness Session" was organized by the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), the Idea and Innovation Cell, and the SSIP Cell at VNSGU on 1st October, 2024, in the Department of Information and Communication Technology, Veer Narmad South Gujarat University, Surat. A total of 57 participants attended this Session.

The main purpose of the startup session in the Department of Information and Communication Technology was to create awareness of startups, innovation,









And leadership among students. Veer Narmad South Gujarat University believes in providing the wings to generate innovative ideas and nurture students to establish their startups by promoting their entrepreneurial spirit. It is often said that to make India stronger, we must first strengthen its roots; our roots lie in the country's interiors, rural areas, and villages. With this motto, the Institution's Innovation Council organized a startup awareness session for the students of the Department of Information and Communication Technology at VNSGU.

The welcome address was given by Dr. Hitesh Lad, Assistant Professor of the Information and Communication Technology department. Dr. Lad provided a brief introduction to the speakers and discussed some of the challenges faced by their department, as well as the work done by faculty and students to address these issues. He also mentioned various problems that startups in India encounter and encouraged students to think of suitable solutions.

Students from the Information and Communication Technology Department generally come from an IT background, enabling them to understand the challenges in the IT sector. Mr. Divyesh Baraiya discussed the definition and meaning of startups. He explained how startups are disrupting markets by providing examples such as Ola (in the taxi sector) and Zomato.

He also highlighted some challenges faced by student entrepreneurs, such as a lack of financial support and proper mentoring. Due to these challenges, many students abandon their startup ideas in favour of seeking jobs. Mr. Baraiya clarified the difference between a business and a startup by providing relevant examples and discussed the essential elements of success.

Mrs. Devanshi Solanki began her segment by explaining the SSIP 2.0 policy and the process to receive funds under this initiative, as well as government aids available to help students nurture their ideas and develop prototypes. She motivated students by sharing examples of successful startups from VNSGU students and alumni, concluding the session with inspiring stories of successful startups.

To conclude the session, Dr. Hitesh Lad delivered the vote of thanks, expressing









Gratitude to the speakers, Mrs. Devanshi Solanki and Mr. Divyesh, for taking the time to share their knowledge with the participants. He also thanked the Institution's Innovation Council, the Ministry of Education's Cell, MHRD, and Veer Narmad South Gujarat University for their support throughout the session.
