Under the *Institution’s Innovation Council, as an MIC-driven Activity for Quarter 2, the faculty and students of Parul University attended the online session ‘Q& A - Orientation Session of Institution’s Innovation Council (IIC) 5.0, from 11:00 am, on 11th January 2023.* This event was hosted by MoE Innovation Cell, and presented by Dr. Dipan Kumar Sahu, Assistant Innovation Director, MoE Innovation Cell, Government of India, and New Delhi. All queries related to the new features of IIC 5.0 had been posted IIC members. In this session, these queries related to the new features were addressed in detail by the host. *More than 50 participants from university attended this session like Innovation ambassadors and students participated in this session.*

Institution Innovation Cell

Ministry of HRD has established Institutes Innovation Cell with the mandate to work closely with our Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to encourage the Creative energy of our student population to work on new ideas and innovation and promote them to create start-ups and entrepreneurial ventures. Innovation Cell will focus on creating a complete ecosystem that will foster the culture of Innovation across all educational institutions from ideas generation to pre-incubation, incubation, and graduating from the incubator as successful start-ups.

The primary mandate of MIC is to encourage, inspire, and nurture young students by supporting them to work with new ideas while they are in formative years. MIC has envisioned the creation of the Institutional Innovation Council (IICs) across selected HEIs. A network of these IICs will be established to promote innovation in the Institution through multitudinous modes leading to an innovation promotion ecosystem on these campuses.

Major Focus:

To create a vibrant local innovation ecosystem.

1. Start-up/ entrepreneurship supporting Mechanism in HEIs.
2. Prepare institute for Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements Framework (ARIIA).
3. Establish Function Ecosystem for Scouting Ideas and Pre-incubation of Ideas.
4. Develop better Cognitive Ability among Technology Students.

Functions of IIC

To conduct various innovation and entrepreneurship-related activities prescribed by Central MIC in time bound fashion.

1. Identify and reward innovations and share success stories.
2. Organize periodic workshops/ seminars/ interactions with entrepreneurs, Investors, professionals and create a mentor pool for student innovators.
3. Network with peers and national entrepreneurship development organizations.
4. Create an Institution's Innovation portal to highlight innovative projects Carried out by institution's faculty and students.
5. Organize Hackathons, idea competition, mini-challenges etc. with the Involvement of industries.
