About Event: As part of the SSIP 2.0 initiative, the Commissionerate of Higher Education (CHE) and the SSIP Cell of Government Science College, Gandhinagar, jointly organized a Student Sensitization Drive on "Building a Proof of Concept (PoC) & Prototype" on March 24, 2025. The session, conducted online via Microsoft Teams with in-person participation in Room No. N-11, saw 68+ students actively engaging. Ms. Prachi Desai from CHE led the session, providing valuable insights into PoC development and prototyping. She emphasized the role of PoC in validating innovative ideas, its significance in attracting funding, and real-world case studies of successful prototypes. The session included an interactive Q&A, allowing students to address their queries. This initiative aimed to equip students with essential knowledge and skills to transform their ideas into viable prototypes.

The interactive Q&A session allowed participants to discuss challenges they might face in developing prototypes. The event encouraged students to think critically about transforming their innovative concepts into tangible products.
