
2. Promoting Entrepreneurship:

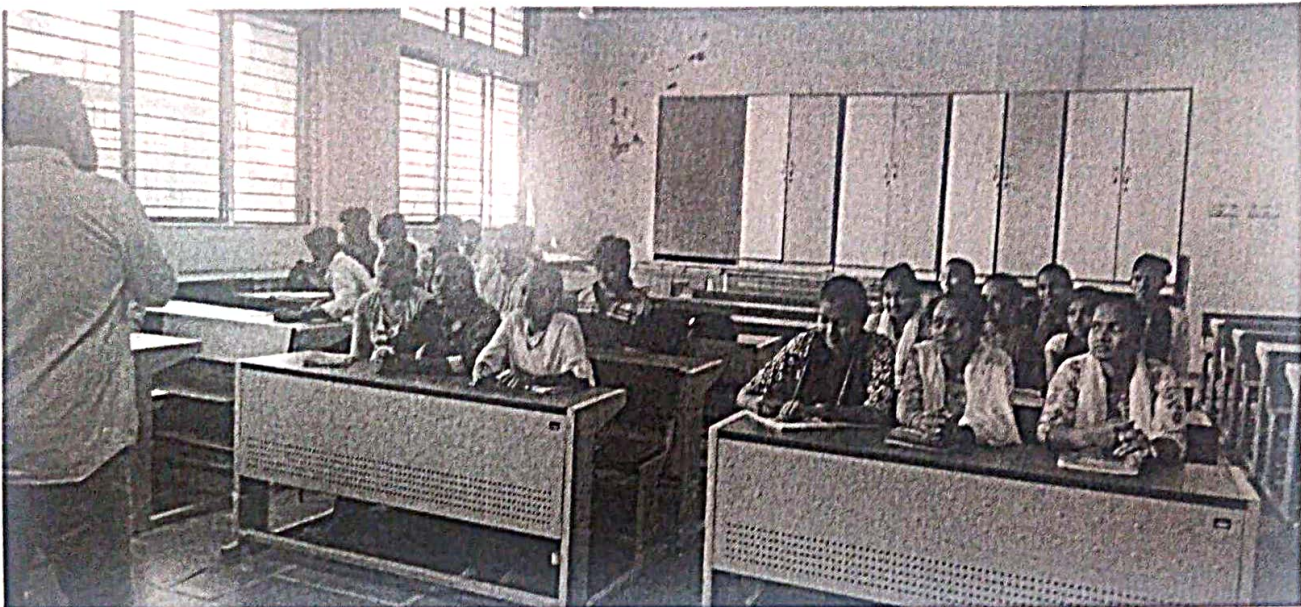


