4) Description of the Event:

Under the esteemed leadership of Hon. Vice-Chancellor Dr. Kishorsinh Chavda and Hon. Registrar Dr. Rameshdan Gadhvi, Veer Narmad South Gujarat University (VNSGU), in collaboration with the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell (MIC) and AICTE, organized a one-day district-level awareness program on 9th July 2025 at 1:30 PM in the Seminar Hall of the Computer Science Department.

The primary objective of the program was to raise awareness and provide guidance on Innovation, the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), and Start-ups.

The program was graced by faculty members from various university departments, principals and innovation coordinators of affiliated colleges across the district, along with other faculty members and students.

The event commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Deepali Gupta, Assistant Professor, Department of Public Administration.

Session 1 Mr. Shyamsundar S introduced the nationwide initiatives undertaken by the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell. He guided participants on how student and faculty patents can be commercialized, the process of launching a startup, and how to effectively communicate accurate and relevant information to students.

Session 2 Mr. Jyotin Kateshiya spoke about the establishment of Institution's Innovation Councils (IICs) in colleges. He detailed the types of activities these councils can undertake and the programs they are expected to organize. He also shared valuable insights into expert talks, student entrepreneurship programs, and reporting procedures.

Session 3 Mr. Mitesh Vadhar focused on the role of Innovation Cells and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), including trademarks, patents, designs, and copyrights. He explained the filing process for these rights and informed participants about government funding schemes available for such initiatives.

The event concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Paresh Parekh.
