Introduction

Parul Innovation and Entrepreneurship Research Centre (PIERC), Parul University, organized a **three-day Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Entrepreneurship and Innovation** from **10th to 12th June 2025**. The FDP was designed to empower faculty members with knowledge and skills that would help them guide and mentor students in entrepreneurial initiatives.

The program aligned with the **National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP)** and the objectives of the **Institute Innovation Council (IIC)**. It also showcased PIERC's efforts in strengthening the innovation ecosystem by connecting faculty with experienced mentors, startup founders, and incubation experts.

Objectives

The FDP was designed with the following objectives:

- To provide an understanding of India's startup ecosystem and entrepreneurial opportunities.
- To train faculty members in design thinking, creativity, and innovation methodologies.







- To familiarize participants with the Business Model Canvas (BMC), Value Proposition Design, and startup management tools.
- To highlight **government funding schemes** and incubation processes supporting startups.
- To encourage faculties to create action plans for **integrating entrepreneurship** into academics.
- To foster a collaborative mindset where faculty become mentors and innovation facilitators for students.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of the FDP, participants were able to:

- Develop an in-depth understanding of **startup life cycles** and entrepreneurial journeys.
- Apply design thinking frameworks to problem-solving and innovation.
- Facilitate idea generation, validation, and evaluation among students.
- Guide startups using tools like BMC and Value Proposition Canvas.
- Create linkages with **government schemes and funding opportunities** to support student ventures.
- Understand incubation and onboarding processes to connect students with PIERC.
- Formulate **action plans** to integrate innovation-based teaching practices into their curriculum.

Program Details & Expert Sessions

Day 1: Exploring Startup Ecosystem & Creativity

- **Briefing on FDP & PIERC** *Mr. Jay Sudani* opened the program by highlighting PIERC's initiatives, achievements, and facilities such as the **FabLab**, incubation spaces, and startup support programs.
- Startup Ecosystem & Life Cycle Mr. Hardik Kharva introduced India's growing startup ecosystem, government initiatives like Startup India, Atal Innovation Mission, and SISFS. He explained the stages of the startup life cycle from ideation to scaling and exit.







- Ice-breaking & Team-building Activities Mr. Prashant Khanna, Ms. Riddhi Bagha, and Ms. Sonal Sudani engaged participants in activities to encourage collaboration.
- Creativity & Idea Generation -Mr. Jay Sudani conducted sessions that included brainstorming exercises and lateral thinking techniques, followed by a group activity on idea evaluation.

Day 2: Innovation Frameworks & Startup Experiences

- **Design Thinking for Innovation** *Mr. Jay Sudani* conducted a highly interactive session on **empathize-define-ideate-prototype-test**, where participants applied design thinking to real-world case studies.
- Value Proposition Design Focused on how startups must clearly define customer problems and value delivery. Participants worked in teams on Value Proposition Canvas exercises using startup examples.
- Group Activities Hands-on practice of BMC and Value Proposition Canvas, with 3–4 startup case studies analyzed in groups.
- Interaction with Startups (Moderated by Mr. Nikhil Jumde) In this key session, three incubated startups at PIERC FlyAnyTrip, Old Veda, and Voldbug were introduced. Their founders shared their startup journey, challenges faced, and the support received from PIERC. Importantly, they provided feedback on how faculty members can play a significant role in guiding and mentoring students, encouraging them to convert ideas into impactful ventures. This session gave participants real-time exposure to student-driven entrepreneurship.

Day 3: Business Models, Funding & Action Plans

- Business Model Canvas (BMC) Mr. Hutesh Baviskar explained components such as customer segments, key partners, revenue models, and unit economics, followed by Mr. Himansu Das providing practical startup case insights.
- Government Funding Schemes for Startups Ms. Sonal Sudani, Mr. Nikhil Jumde, and Mr. Prashant Khanna highlighted schemes like SISFS, MSME support, DST & DBT funds, and innovation challenges that startups can leverage.







- Startup Incubation & Onboarding -Mr. Anup Chaudhari explained the application process, evaluation methods, mentorship support, and PIERC's startup dictionary.
- **MBA** in Entrepreneurship & Innovation *Mr. Prashant Khanna* introduced PIERC's specialized MBA program that combines academic learning with incubation support.
- Action Plans & Feedback Faculty participants presented action plans for integrating innovation into teaching. The session, led by Mr. Jay Sudani and Mr. Hutesh Baviskar, also included feedback sharing and networking.
- Visit to Incubation Centre & FabLab Participants toured PIERC's incubation facilities, gaining exposure to prototyping tools, startup offices, and innovation labs.
- Closing Ceremony Certificates were distributed, marking the successful completion of the FDP.

Participant Engagement

- The FDP witnessed active participation from **faculty across multiple disciplines** including engineering, management, pharmacy, and design.
- More than **60 faculty members** attended the program, engaging in brainstorming activities, case studies, and startup discussions.
- The session featuring FlyAnyTrip, Old Veda, and Voldbug founders was particularly impactful, as it directly connected faculty with the entrepreneurial experiences of student-led startups.

Impact & Future Scope

- The FDP empowered faculty members to become **innovation facilitators and startup mentors** for their students.
- The real-life sharing by student entrepreneurs (FlyAnyTrip, Old Veda, Voldbug) highlighted the **critical role of faculty mentorship** in supporting early-stage student startups.
- Faculty participants expressed interest in **collaborating with PIERC** for future projects, hackathons, and mentoring activities.







- The action plans prepared by participants will contribute to embedding entrepreneurial culture into classrooms.
- The FDP is expected to create a **multiplier effect**, as trained faculty will guide hundreds of students in innovation and entrepreneurship across Parul University.

Conclusion

The Faculty Development Program on Innovation and Entrepreneurship (10th–12th June 2025) at Parul University was a resounding success. It provided an enriching blend of conceptual knowledge, practical insights, and interactive activities. With expert sessions, startup interactions, and visits to innovation facilities, the FDP built strong faculty capacity to promote entrepreneurship.
