Objective of the Program

The objective of the Intra-Institutional Start-up Competition was to provide a dedicated platform for student innovators of Parul University to present their start-up ideas, receive mentorship, and explore incubation opportunities. The competition aimed to encourage entrepreneurial thinking, identify potential start-ups, and reward promising ventures with recognition, incubation support, and funding from PIERC.

Learning Outcomes

- Students developed the ability to conceptualize and structure innovative business ideas.
- Participants improved their skills in pitching, presentation, and defending business models before experts.
- The mentoring process enhanced students' understanding of market validation, customer needs, and scalability.

Details of the Program

The **Intra-Institutional Start-up Competition** was conducted over three days, engaging students across various disciplines to showcase their entrepreneurial ideas.

- **Day 1 (3rd June 2025): Idea Presentation Round**

The program began with an orientation session, followed by the first round of presentations. More than **20 start-up ideas** were pitched by student teams from diverse domains such as technology, healthcare, education, sustainability, and social innovation. Each team presented their idea to a panel of evaluators and received constructive feedback.

- **Day 2 (4th June 2025): Mentorship & Refinement**

On the second day, participants received one-on-one mentorship by incubation managers. The focus was on refining their business models, conducting market validation, and strengthening their pitch strategies. The mentors guided students in identifying practical challenges and aligning their solutions for real-world impact.

- **Day 3 (5th June 2025): Final Pitching & Awards**

The final day witnessed the shortlisted start-ups presenting their refined ideas and prototypes to the jury panel. Again, **20+ start-up teams** pitched their innovative solutions, demonstrating significant improvement from the mentorship received.

- The best start-ups were **selected for incubation and funding support at PIERC**, giving them access to resources, mentorship, and networking opportunities.
- The event concluded with a reward ceremony, recognizing the most promising start-ups and encouraging all participants to continue their entrepreneurial journey.

Conclusion

The Intra-Institutional Start-up Competition successfully created a platform for student innovators to showcase their entrepreneurial potential. With over 20+ start-up ideas presented each day, expert mentorship, and the selection of promising ventures for incubation and funding, the event strengthened the start-up ecosystem within Parul

University. It not only rewarded innovation but also inspired students to pursue entrepreneurship as a meaningful career path.

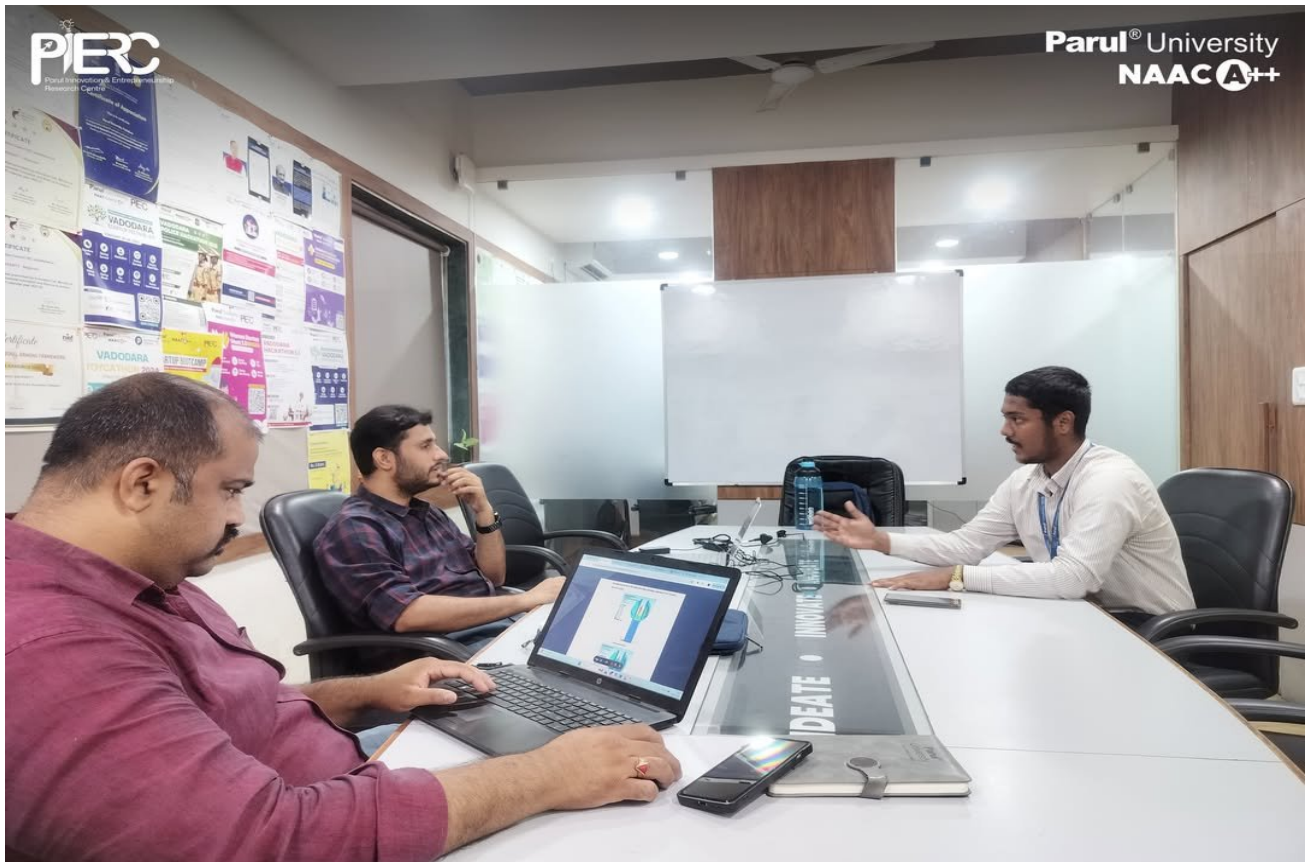
