- Challenges faced by first-time innovators and how ecosystem enablers provide hand-holding at every step.
- Encouragement for students to actively participate in hackathons, ideathons, and national innovation challenges.

- Students were informed about grants, mentorship, and incubator access through regional and national platforms.
- Faculty gained clarity on how to mentor students through IIC and SSIP-supported projects.
