Highlights of Session

The Innovation, Ideation & Problem-Solving Awareness Session was conducted on 3rd and 5th September 2025 at Government School No. 3, School No. 19, and School No. 20 in Nadiad. The sessions introduced young students to the basics of thinking creatively, finding new ideas, and understanding how simple problems around them can lead to useful solutions.

The aim of the program was to help primary school children develop curiosity, imagination, and confidence in expressing their ideas. Through interactive activities and easy examples, students were encouraged to observe their surroundings, identify small problems, and think of innovative ways to solve them.

The session also gave students a basic understanding of how innovation is supported in schools and how young learners can take small steps toward turning their ideas into meaningful projects.

As an outcome, the students became more aware of creative thinking, team-based problemsolving, and the importance of sharing new ideas. The program helped spark their interest in learning beyond textbooks and motivated them to look at everyday challenges with a creative mindset.
