He has worked with a national-level organisation, Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India (EDII), for promoting entrepreneurship across the state through various Government interventions. The main purpose of organising the event is to celebrate the National Entrepreneurship Day, which is celebrated every year on 09th November among the School Students of Standard 8 & Standard 9.

Objective of the Event:

The major objective of the event is below:

- To create awareness among students about entrepreneurship and its role in economic and social development.
- To develop an entrepreneurial mind-set by encouraging creativity, innovation, and problem-solving skills.
- To introduce the basic concepts of start-ups, business ideas, risk-taking, and leadership.
- To inspire students through real-life examples of successful entrepreneurs and young innovators.
- To motivate students to consider entrepreneurship as a potential career option in the future.
- To promote critical thinking and teamwork through interactive activities and discussions.
- To build confidence among students to express new ideas and solutions to everyday problems.
- To provide early exposure to how entrepreneurs contribute to society, employment creation, and nation-building.

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Brief Overview of the Event:

Mr. Mineshkumar Prajapati, Head Incubation, conducted an Expert Session on Entrepreneurship and Its Importance

Mr.Mineshkumar Prajapati, Head Incubation, IAR University, has started his session with a definition of entrepreneurship, personal characteristics of successful entrepreneurs, entrepreneurship and the entrepreneurial process and successful teenage entrepreneurs from India.

He has explained that "An Entrepreneur is a person who undertakes the risk associated with creating, organising, and owning a business." He has talked about personal characteristics of successful entrepreneurs like Persistent, creative, responsible, Inquisitive, goal-oriented, independent, self-confident and risk-taker. He has talked about Skills needed by entrepreneurs like communication skills, human relations skills, math skills, problem solving and decision making skill, technical skill and basic business skill.

He has talked about Entrepreneurship and Entrepreneurs. He has explained about five steps of the entrepreneurial process: Discovery, Concept development, resourcing, actualization and harvesting in detail.

He has also explained about Success story of Mr. Ritesh Agrawal, Founder of OYO(On Your Own) with the students.

Outcome of the Event:

- Students gained a clear understanding of what entrepreneurship means.
 Qualities of an entrepreneur, Importance of innovation, problem-solving and creativity.
- Students were encouraged to think beyond traditional career options.
- Real-life examples of young entrepreneurs inspired them to believe that age is not a barrier to innovation.
- Students understood that failure is part of learning.
- They realized that entrepreneurship involves effort, risk-taking, and perseverance.
- Teachers appreciated the session for its practical approach.
- Students showed interest in participating in such activities regularly.
