Mr. Milan Trivedi, Assistant Professor & IIC Coordinator, explained the significance of National Education Day.

He highlighted the remarkable contributions of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, India's first Minister of Education as below:

- ♣ Established key institutions: He founded the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kharagpur in 1951, the University Grants Commission (UGC) in 1953, and the Central Institute of Education in Delhi (now the Department of Education at Delhi University).
- ♣ Promoted science and technology: He recognized the importance of scientific and technological development, laying the groundwork for institutions like the IITs and IIMs.
- **Championed universal education:** He advocated for *free and compulsory* education up to age 14 and emphasized the need for teacher training.
- ♣ Strengthened cultural ties: He established the Indian Council for Cultural Relations to promote cultural connections between India and other countries.
- **Modernized higher education:** He laid the foundation for modern higher education in India with a liberal and humanistic approach.






