



The Centre was formally established in 2017 u/s 8 of The Companies Act, 2013, with a vision to provide state-of-the-art support and service to innovators, technocrats and entrepreneurs who aim to create a social and economic pact in society through innovative solutions to existing problems. The centre acts complementary to the academic and research activities of the University.

PDEU IIC has also been approved to be a **"Technology Business Incubator"**, a recognition by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India. It is recognized as a Nodal Institute by the Government of Gujarat. ### Inaugural Ceremony


Once the participants had settled in, the facilitators, **Mr. Aditya Dave** and **Mr. Darshan Parekh**, officially opened the session by introducing themselves and presenting an overview of Startup Weekend. They outlined the **objectives of the event**, detailed the planned activities, and shared what participants could look forward to over the next three days. The mentors and organizing team were also introduced, creating a welcoming, collaborative atmosphere. The session then transitioned into a high tea break, offering participants an opportunity to relax and begin networking with one another.

## Ice Breaker Activity

To help participants loosen up, feel comfortable, and engage with one another, the facilitators introduced a fun activity called **Half Baked**. In this exercise, participants generated random words, formed groups, and collaboratively developed a quirky idea, even sketching out a logo on paper. The room was filled with laughter as everyone let their creativity flow and began building new connections, setting the foundation for future teamwork.



## Dinner and Networking

As evening fell, dinner was served, providing participants with a chance to relax and enjoy their meal while engaging in **lively discussions** about the day's activities and the ideas pitched.

## Choosing the Best Ideas

Following dinner, attention shifted to selecting the best ideas. Participants cast their votes using sticky notes, thoughtfully considering each concept through lively discussions. In the end, **20 ideas** stood out as the most promising, capturing the group's interest and enthusiasm.

## Forming Teams

After the top ideas were selected, the real work began. The 20 innovators whose ideas were selected stepped into team leader roles, selecting fellow participants and convincing them to be a part of the team. By the end of the evening, **groups of five to six members** formed, ready to further work and develop their ideas.

As the first day concluded, the atmosphere was charged with enthusiasm. **New connections** were made, ideas began to take shape, and anticipation for the journey ahead was clearly visible. This marked the beginning of an **exciting startup adventure**.

## Workshop on Design Thinking 101

In the **Design Thinking 101 workshop**, **Mr. Aditya Dave** guided participants through the process of taking an idea from concept to customer. He emphasized the importance of adopting a problem-solving mindset, using the **"Why"** framework to uncover root causes, and applying structured methods to identify target customers and markets. The session also highlighted the value of **rapid testing** and **validation**, alongside the **perseverance** required for entrepreneurial success. By the end, participants had practical tools to prototype, test, and effectively grow their ideas.



### Workshop By Ms. Ishita Hundia (Speaker - Wellness Analytics & Culture Strategist)

**Day Two** began with an interactive workshop **Brand Avatar Lab: Designing the Face of Your Brand, led by Ms. Ishita Hundia**. The session guided participants in developing unique and memorable brand personalities, exploring how visuals, tone, and storytelling contribute to a brand's identity. Through engaging exercises, participants learned to **create avatars** that authentically represent their brand values and resonate with their target audience. It was an enriching experience that combined creativity with **strategic thinking** to bring brands to life.

The mentoring sessions emerged to be one of the key elements of the event, offering teams the opportunity to engage **one-on-one** with mentors with **20+ industry experts**. ## Workshop on How to Pitch in 5 Minutes


The **How to Pitch in 5 Minutes** workshop, conducted by **Mr. Darshan Parekh**, equipped participants with the core skills needed to deliver a strong pitch. The session emphasized key **judging criteria**, including the necessity of validating the problem with customers, confirming its authenticity, and clearly defining the target market. Participants learned **how to structure a pitch** by clearly outlining the problem, presenting a viable solution, demonstrating customer validation, and explaining the go-to-market strategy along with the business model. Additionally, the workshop provided **practical tips** on presentation skills, such as choosing the best presenter, communicating effectively, engaging the audience, and backing up claims with credible data.



## Day 3: Pitching Day

### Mock Pitching Sessions

**Day Three** is the most **important day** of Startup Weekend, started with a refreshing breakfast, preparing the teams and setting the tone for the **mock pitch rounds**. During these sessions, teams presented their **final pitches** in front of mentors, who provided **guidance** and **constructive feedback**. These sessions were essential in shaping the startups teams progress, as mentors highlighted strengths, identified gaps, and offered actionable suggestions to refine their pitch decks further.

### The Jury Pitching

After 54 hours of creativity and teamwork, Startup Weekend reached its **climax** with the most awaited **Jury Pitching Round**. Over 20 teams geared up to present their startup ideas to a panel of **04 judges**. Each team had **05 minutes** to deliver their pitch, followed by a **03-minute Q&A session** with the judges. The atmosphere was charged with excitement as teams showcased their innovative solutions, highlighting the problem, proposed solution, market potential, and business strategy. Judges carefully evaluated each presentation, asking questions to assess the feasibility and scalability of the ideas. This session concluded with the judges deliberating to select the most promising startups, recognizing outstanding creativity, strategy, and execution.
