


ABOUT THE EVENT

the illusion of the startup world and what it actually takes to build a venture. Ms. Ekta Shah(Founder & CEO- Biziverse Pvt. Ltd.), who leads a company that supports over 3,000 MSMEs, spoke about women in entrepreneurship; and how being a woman isn't actually a limitation, rather a privilege that adds empathy and perspective to business. Hardik and Vraj- PDEU alumnus, who shared opinions on involvement of AI into resource-heavy industries and process of validation of ideas to find the first user.

The keynote speech was delivered by Mr. Abhinav Kapadia which highlighted the role played by PDEU IIC in the academic sphere of PDEU campus. Students understood the mindset required to make an idea into a successful business. The questions from the audience side deep dived into the respective expertise of panelists.


