## **Report on National Youth Day Celebration: Screening of Youth Innovators' Documentary: Story of Idea to Action**

The documentary titled *Under 25 and Already Changing India | The Young Innovators Blueprint* was screened with the objective of inspiring students by showcasing real-life stories of young Indian innovators who are making meaningful contributions to society through creativity, empathy, and problem-solving. The programme was organized by Dr. Dipika Kevlani, SSIP & Innovation Coordinator, under the guidance of Principal Dr. J. R. Vanza.
