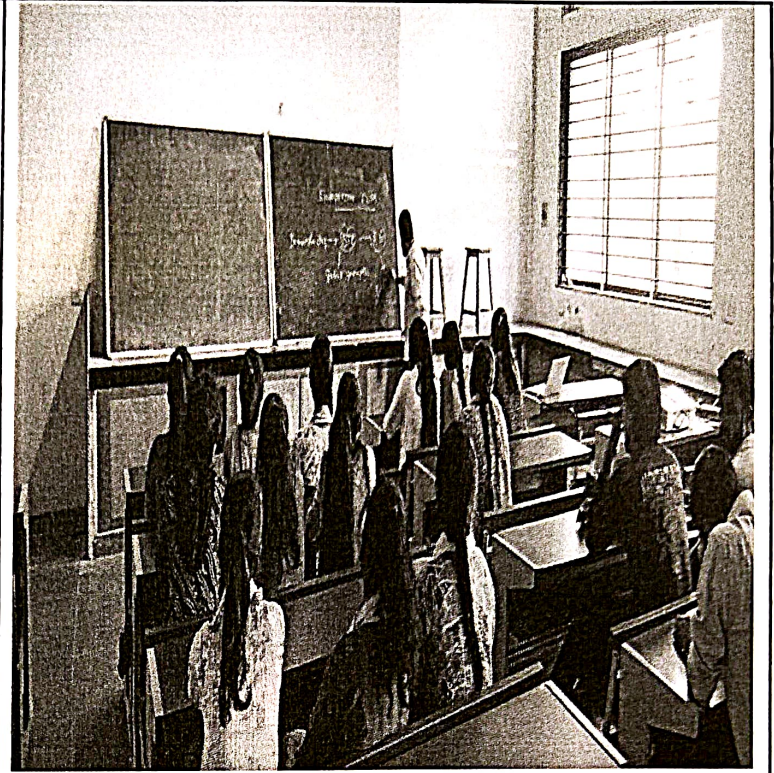


1. **Resource Provision:** To provide necessary resources such as funding, mentorship, and workspace to student entrepreneurs.
