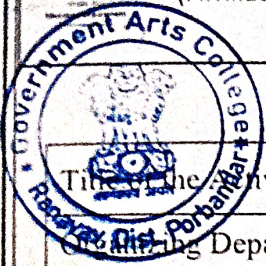

## DETAILED REPORT
