 2. **Innovation:** Providing resources for research and development.
 3. **Startup:** Assisting with the formalization of business ideas.
 4. **Scale-Up:** Supporting the growth and expansion of successful student ventures.
 - **Financial Assistance:** Students were briefed on the availability of grants for building Proof of Concepts (PoC), filing patents, and developing prototypes.
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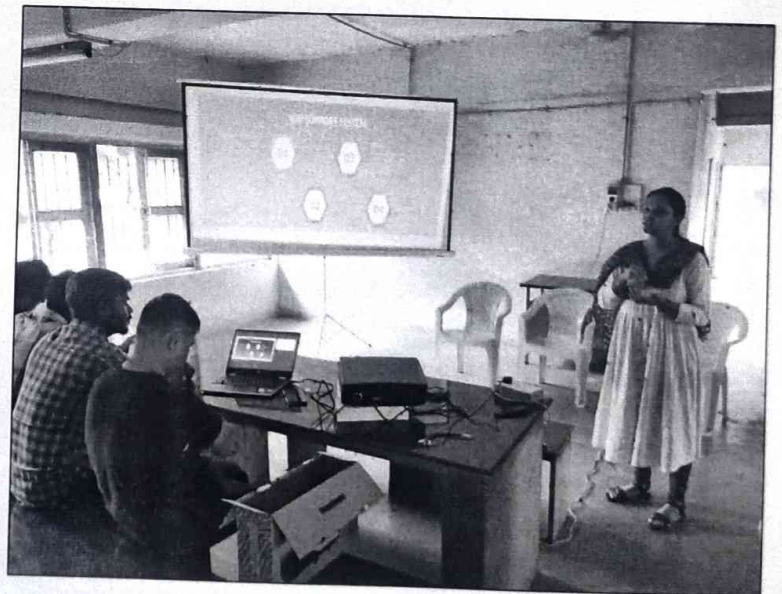
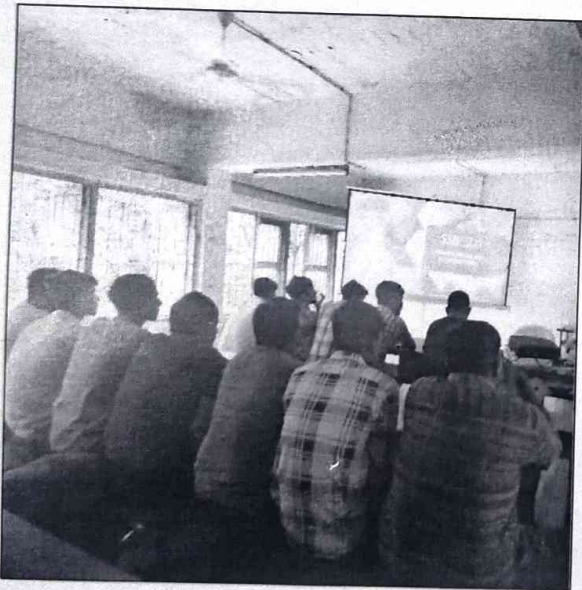
4. Program Highlights


