

Report: SSIP 2.0 Awareness Session for S.Y.B.Sc. Students

Overview

A specialized awareness session on the **Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP 2.0)** was conducted by Dr. Falguni Sheth for the second-year science students at Government Science College, Bhilad. The session was designed to sensitize students to the robust entrepreneurial ecosystem provided by the Government of Gujarat and to encourage the transition from academic learning to innovative application.

Key Discussion Points

- **Policy Framework:** Dr. Sheth provided a detailed walkthrough of the SSIP 2.0 framework, which is specifically designed to support the "mind-to-market" journey of student innovators.
- **Financial Support:** Students were informed about the availability of financial grants, including up to **₹2.5 Lakhs** for the development of Proof of Concepts (PoC) and physical prototypes.
- **Intellectual Property (IPR):** The session emphasized the importance of protecting original ideas through patents and trademarks, highlighting the substantial support provided by the policy for IPR filings.
- **Mindset Transformation:** Using success stories and case studies, Dr. Sheth encouraged the 22 participating students to leverage their scientific knowledge to solve real-world industrial and societal problems.

Impact and Conclusion

The session successfully engaged the S.Y.B.Sc. cohort, fostering a deeper understanding of how to access government resources for technical innovation. By highlighting that students should aspire to be **job creators rather than job seekers**, Dr. Sheth effectively motivated the participants to explore entrepreneurship as a viable and supported career path within the Gujarat startup ecosystem.
