The following points were discussed about Student Startup & Innovation Policy 2.0.

- Eligibility and Benefits were explained.
- **Support for Prototyping:** SSIP has created mechanism through which students, innovators, start-ups can be given up to 2 lakh INR for developing prototype. Through State SSIP grant committee deserving teams can even fetch grant more than 2 lakh per project as per the need.
- **Support for IPR:** Through SSIP, innovators can avail average 25 lakh INR grant for domestic IPR filing. SSIP also mandates student innovators for IPR protection beyond India and gives incentives for them.
