-  Motivation for students to take initiative and develop entrepreneurial projects aligned with India's innovation mission.

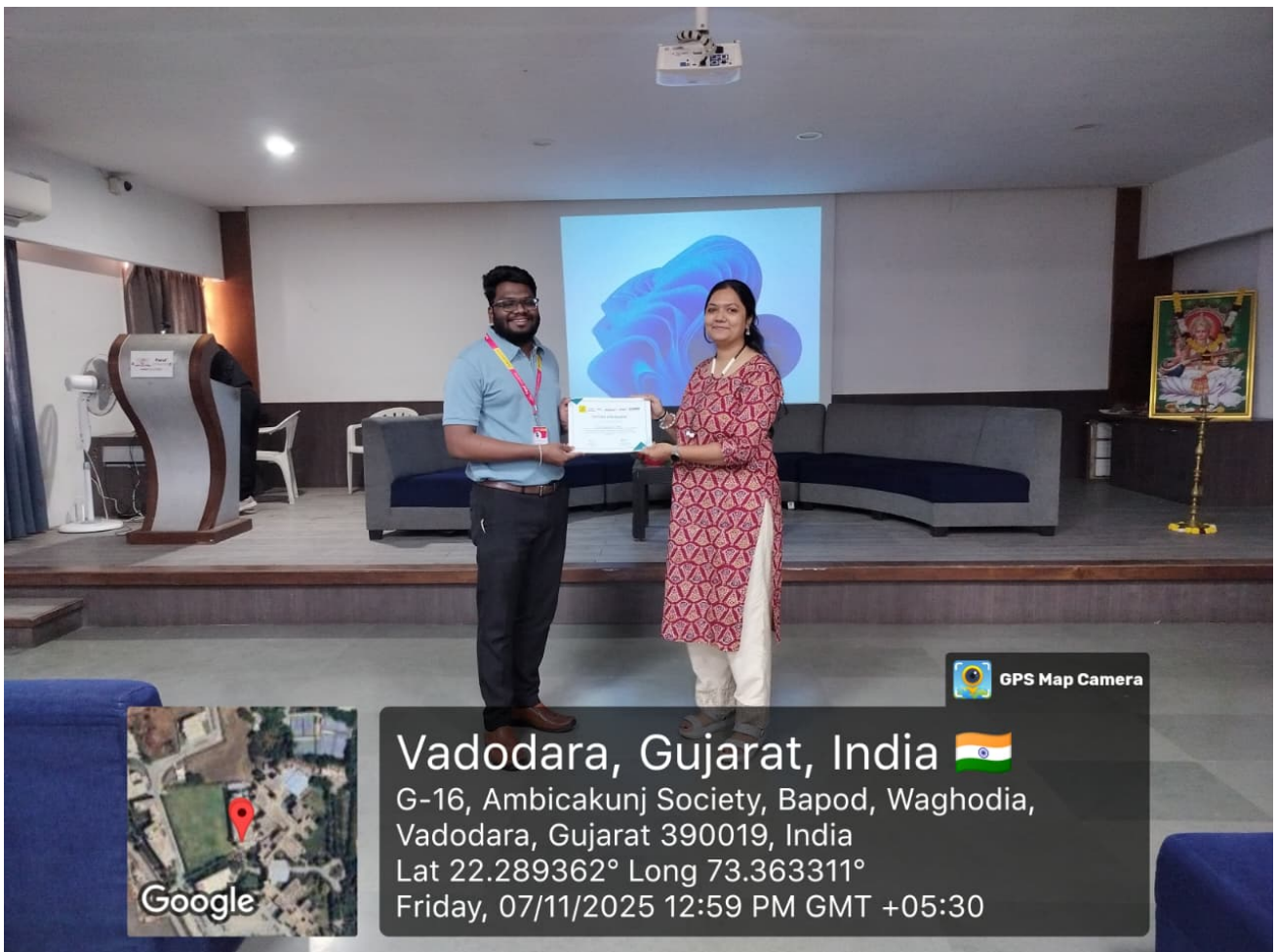
Learning Outcomes:
