

REPORT ON " SSIP 2.0 Awareness session for Newly Admitted Students-2026" SESSION

1. Introduction

Government Polytechnic, Rajpipla organized an informative session titled "**SSIP 2.0 Awareness Session for Newly Admitted Students-2026**" on 4 August 2026. The seminar aimed to introduce the incoming batch of diploma students to the Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP 2.0) of the Gujarat government. The event took place from 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM.

2. Objectives

- To educate new students about the state government's SSIP 2.0 framework.
- To explain the financial and infrastructural support available for student innovations.
- To cultivate an entrepreneurial mindset and problem-solving attitude from day one.

3. Event Proceedings

The orientation was systematically delivered across two main segments:

Phase 1: Policy Insights & Government Grants (10:30 AM - 11:30 AM)

- **Keynote Presentation:** Prof. V.Y. Doshi Sir decoded the core pillars of the SSIP 2.0 policy.
- **Funding Disbursal:** He explained how students can claim financial assistance up to ₹2.5 Lakhs for proof-of-concept (PoC) development and prototyping.
- **IPR Support:** The expert detailed the pathways to secure intellectual property rights (IPR) and patents with government funding support.

Phase 2: Idea Incubation & Open Forum (11:30 AM - 12:30 PM)

- **Mindset Building:** Prof. Doshi shared real-world student success stories who transformed basic college projects into commercially viable startups.
- **Scouting Challenges:** Students learned how to look for everyday industrial and societal problems to convert into business ideas.
- **Q&A Session:** The speaker addressed student doubts regarding team formulation, interdisciplinary projects, and how to pitch ideas to the institute's SSIP committee.

4. Key Outcomes

- **Policy Awareness:** 66 newly admitted students gained clear knowledge of how to leverage institutional and state funds for their creative ideas.
- **Ecosystem Integration:** Freshers learned how to approach the institute's internal SSIP cell for mentoring and financial approvals.
- **Inspiration:** The session motivated students to look beyond traditional job seeking and explore pathways toward job creation
