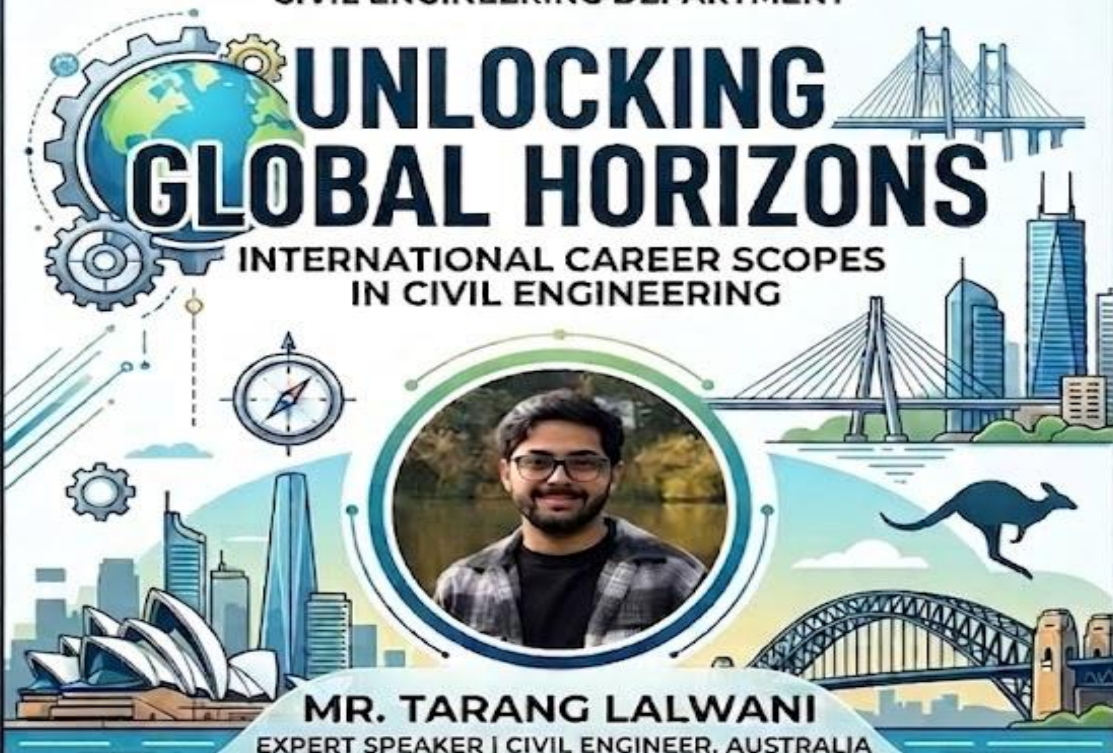

On 12 August 2026, an informative and interactive alumni seminar was organized at Shantilal Shah Engineering College for the students of the Civil Engineering Department from the 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th semesters. The session was conducted by Mr. Tarang Lalwani, an alumnus of Shantilal Shah Engineering College who passed out in 2023. He is currently working as a Graduate Engineer at Spiire in Geelong, Victoria, Australia, and has pursued a Master of Engineering (Civil/Professional) from Deakin University. He has also served as a Deakin TALENT Career Ambassador for the 2025 batch and is associated with Engineers Australia. **Total 124 students** actively participated in the event.

During the seminar, Mr. Lalwani shared his academic and professional journey and explained the importance of developing practical and technical skills along with academic knowledge. He particularly emphasized the importance of learning Civil Engineering software and other industry-relevant digital tools, explaining how software proficiency can improve students' technical abilities and employability. He also shared his experience of pursuing higher education and building a professional career in Australia and provided valuable guidance to students interested in studying abroad. He explained the important steps students should follow, including maintaining good academic performance, developing technical skills, improving English-language proficiency, preparing a strong CV, researching suitable universities and courses, understanding eligibility requirements, and planning applications properly.

Another important part of the seminar focused on CV preparation and job applications, where he explained how students can make their CV more impressive by highlighting relevant software skills, academic projects, internships, certifications, achievements, and other professional activities. He also discussed common mistakes that students should avoid, such as using the same CV for every application, including irrelevant information, making grammatical or formatting errors, mentioning skills without proper knowledge, ignoring practical

experience, and waiting until the final year to prepare for jobs or higher studies. An interactive question-and-answer session was also conducted, during which students asked questions related to Civil Engineering software, higher studies abroad, career opportunities, CV preparation, job applications, and mistakes to avoid while applying to universities or companies. Mr. Lalwani answered the students' questions and shared practical suggestions based on his own experiences.

At the conclusion of the seminar, Prof. K. B. Gohil honored and felicitated Mr. Tarang Lalwani with a token of appreciation and a “Thank You” memento for sharing his valuable knowledge, experience, and career guidance with the students. The seminar provided valuable exposure to students and motivated them to focus on a combination of academic knowledge, technical skills, software proficiency, practical experience, communication skills, and professional development. Overall, the session was highly informative and beneficial, giving Civil Engineering students a clearer understanding of career planning, opportunities for higher studies abroad, the importance of industry-relevant skills, and the steps they can take during their undergraduate studies to build a successful professional career.
