1. Objective of the Programme

The programme was organized to celebrate World Entrepreneurship Day 2026 and to encourage students to develop an entrepreneurial mindset. The seminar focused on transforming innovative ideas into practical solutions and motivating students to consider entrepreneurship and start-ups as career opportunities.

- Create awareness about entrepreneurship and start-up opportunities among students.
- Encourage students to identify business opportunities from real-life problems.
- Develop creativity, innovation and an entrepreneurial mindset.
- Explain the basic process of converting an idea into a start-up.
- Provide awareness about funding and support opportunities.
- Motivate students through real-life entrepreneurial experiences and success stories.

2. Programme Theme

The central theme of the programme was “Entrepreneurship: Zero to Hero – From Idea to Impact”. The programme emphasized that every successful venture begins with an idea and that students can transform their ideas into impactful and sustainable start-ups through innovation, perseverance and proper execution.

3. Key Topics Covered

- Identifying Business Opportunities – observing problems and identifying potential business opportunities.
- Converting Ideas into Innovative Solutions – importance of creativity, innovation and problem-solving.
- Basics of Starting a Start-up – key considerations involved in transforming an idea into a venture.
- Funding and Support Opportunities – awareness about financial support and entrepreneurial support systems.
- Building and Growing a Successful Venture – planning, execution, customer understanding and continuous improvement.
- Real-Life Entrepreneurial Journey and Success Stories – practical experiences and entrepreneurial insights.

4. Highlights of the Programme

The programme provided students with an opportunity to interact with an experienced entrepreneur and understand entrepreneurship from a practical perspective. The journey from

idea generation to innovation, start-up creation and impact was emphasized throughout the session.

5. Student Learning Outcomes

Understanding the importance of an entrepreneurial mindset.

Recognizing problems as potential business opportunities.

Understanding how ideas can be converted into innovative solutions.

Awareness of basic requirements for starting a start-up.

Awareness of funding and entrepreneurial support opportunities.

Understanding the challenges and opportunities involved in building a venture.

Recognizing the importance of innovation, creativity and perseverance.

6. Impact of the Programme

A total of 105 students participated in the programme, demonstrating strong student interest in entrepreneurship, innovation and start-up activities.

The World Entrepreneurship Day celebration created awareness among students regarding entrepreneurship, innovation and start-up culture. The interaction with the speaker helped students understand that entrepreneurship involves problem identification, innovation, risk-taking, execution and creating value for society.
