Government Science College Mandvi organized online Student Sensitization Program “Building a Proof of Concept (PoC) & Prototype” under SSIP CELL in colabaration with HE PMU SSIP 2.0 KCG on 18/08/2026 at Smart Class from 02:30 PM to 04:00 PM. The event aimed at promoting awareness and understanding of the policy among students, fostering a culture of innovation, entrepreneurship, and startups within the institution. SSIP 2.0 is a government initiative designed to provide a nurturing environment for young innovators in Gujarat. The policy seeks to support student-led startups, offering funding and mentorship to promote entrepreneurial spirit. The sensitization program was focused on informing students about the opportunities, processes, and resources available under this policy.
